A MESSAGE TO THE COMMUNITY from the Chairman of the Board and President /CEO

Dear Friends and Supporters,

In fiscal year 2016, we had a lot to boast about. Across the organization, we continued our steadfast commitment to our clients, serving more than 1,600 individuals through a broad array of vital services, delivered in the very communities in which they live, work, and learn. None of this would have been possible without your generous support.

Here are some of our accomplishments...

- In Job Placement and Training. Employment Services helped over 350 consumers find and maintain jobs at local businesses. They earned over \$1,600,000 in income. Other programs within Employment Services, such as Pathways and Direct Placement, provided more job training opportunities through new contracts with businesses like the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), Panera Bread, and Marshalls Department Store, just to name a few. Our Work Services program, which is transitioning through the agency's new "Choice through Discovery" process, successfully started placing individuals in jobs and volunteer programs at local nonprofit partners and businesses. And Sam's Café not only continued to be a popular community meeting place, in April of 2016 it began selling our delicious New Horizons cookies at two local Pavilions stores and opened its doors to the San Fernando Valley Interfaith Council (VIC) in order to serve hot, nutritious lunches to the program's seniors and our own consumers.
- In Educating and Counseling. The Monarch Mobile Day Program (MMDP) and on-campus Achievement Center served more than 200 individuals, helping them to become integrated in the community and achieve life goals. Both programs expanded services by providing additional workers and activities both on and off our North Hills campus.
- In Travel Training. With over 1,500 referrals and 750 trained participants, the *Green Light to Mobility* program offered one-on-one instruction to our clients and community of service providers, establishing New Horizons as experts in the travel training field. The program started offering Senior Travel Training Workshops, eventually leading to many of our consumer participants learning alongside local seniors within the community.
- In Residential Services and Community Living. Through Residential Services and Community Living, our clients continued to safely live their chosen lives with the help of New Horizons' dedicated staff. Whether residing in one of our agency's 12 group homes, or living in their own apartment or home, we saw the lives of our consumers advance in positive ways by helping them stay independent and community minded. As we continue remodeling and improving our group homes, and prepare to move consumers into our thirteenth home, our memory care residence, we remain mindful of their need to be involved in the community and be part of the neighborhoods in which they live.

There is so much more that we all can be proud of here at New Horizons. Like the fact that for two television seasons New Horizons has consulted on the ground-breaking, Emmy award winning A&E docu-series, "Born This Way," lending our expertise and help in creating authentic portrayals of those with developmental disabilities.

But our greatest pride comes from being able to partner with you in providing programs and services that assist our clients achieve so much. With your help, their dreams are becoming reality!
