GoGrocery is a partnership between New Horizons, the Department of Rehabilitation (DOR), and Albertsons and their affiliates in the San Fernando Valley.

Trainees interested in a career in the grocery industry will learn hands-on skills both in our mock training center and at the store sites themselves.

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

Throughout a 10-week training session, participants will learn skills such as bagging, go-backs, cart returns, customer service and other critical abilities needed to be hired in the grocery industry.



COST TO PARTICIPANTS

Thanks to funding by the Department of Rehabilitation (DOR), eligible enrollees will not be charged for the classes. And, during the final assessment, trainees will be paid for their work in the stores!



PROGRAM GRADUATES

Trainees that satisfactorily complete the 10-week course will be eligible to partner with our team of job developers and coaches who will help participants find and keep a job in the grocery field.



HOW TO APPLY

Potential enrollees should contact their DOR counselors and ask to be enrolled in the GoGrocery program. If you are a regional center service consumer, please contact your service coordinator to have a referral packet sent to New Horizons.
