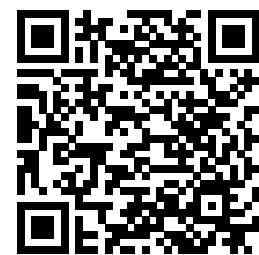

What Is Go4Grocery?

Go4Grocery is a partnership between New Horizons, the California Department of Rehabilitation (DOR), and Albertsons and their affiliates in the San Fernando Valley.

Trainees interested in a career in the grocery industry participate in a 10-week course to learn hands-on skills at our on-campus, simulated grocery store training center and at store sites in the community. The program is open to adults as well as students ages 16-22.

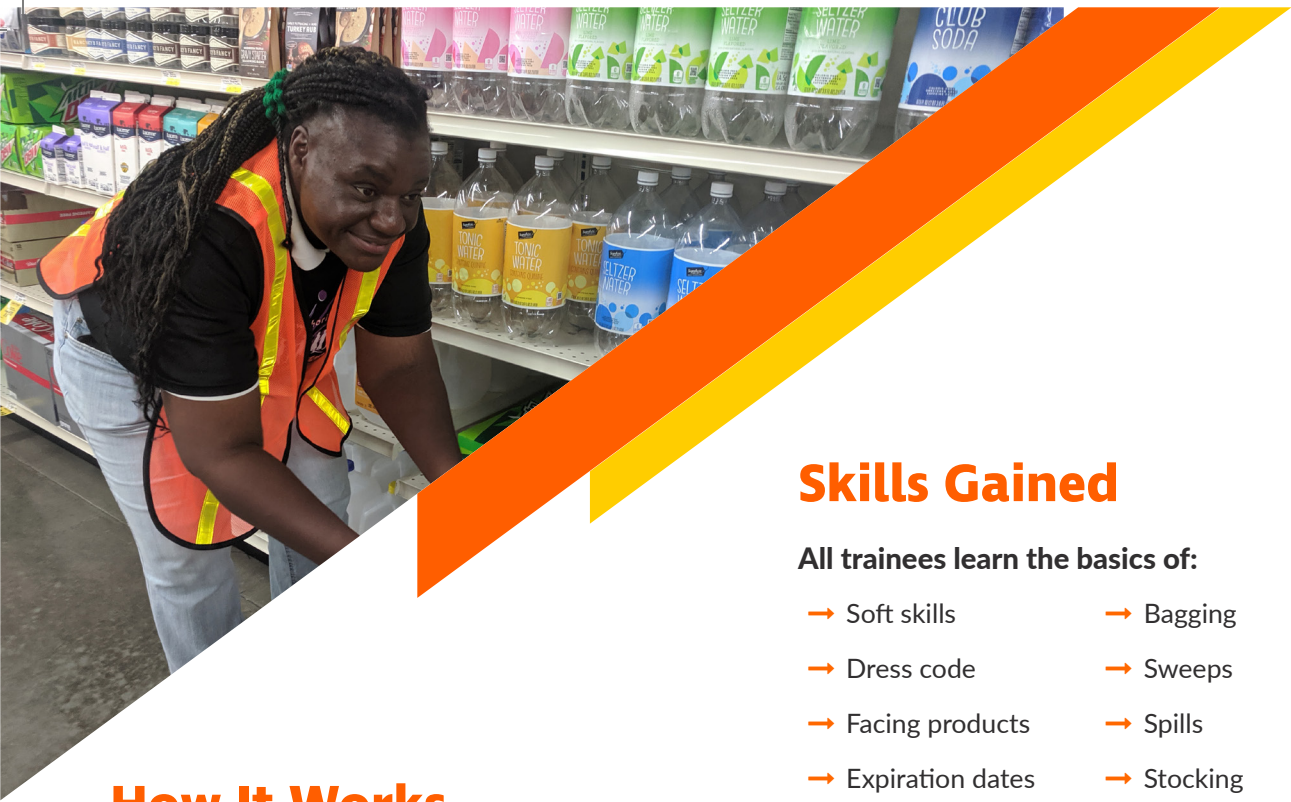

How It Works

NO COST TO PARTICIPATE

Thanks to funding by the California Department of Rehabilitation (DOR), eligible trainees will not be charged for Go4Grocery classes.

HANDS-ON TRAINING

Classes take place over a 10-week period, with four sessions per week. For every four trainees, there is one lead instructor and one support staff member. Classes progress from grocery store basics and skill development to practice in a real or simulated store.

ONGOING SUPPORT

Those who successfully complete the 10-week course will have the opportunity to partner with our team of job developers and coaches, who will help trainees find and keep a job in the grocery field.

Skills Gained

All trainees learn the basics of:

- Soft skills
- Dress code
- Facing products
- Expiration dates
- Go backs
- Carts
- Baskets
- Bagging
- Sweeps
- Spills
- Stocking
- Theft monitoring
- Outside trash

There's also potential to earn certificates of completion toward roles such as:

- Deli assistant
- Bakery clerk
- Floral clerk
- Cashier

How to Enroll

Potential trainees should contact their DOR counselors and ask to be enrolled in the Go4Grocery program. If you are a Regional Center service consumer, please contact your service coordinator to have a referral packet sent to New Horizons. For private placement, contact New Horizons' client engagement and outcomes manager, who will be happy to schedule a tour and answer all questions.
